For Licensing purposes:

I hereby solemnly declare that I am a resident of the Province of British Columbia and that the vehicle described above:

- Is in, and will remain in, a condition that makes it of significant value to a collector or exhibitor of motor vehicles.
- Has been maintained or restored, and will remain in, a condition which conforms to the vehicle manufacturer's original specifications with the exception of upgrading of brakes, headlights and the installation of seatbelts, safety glass or other items satisfactory to ICBC.
- is at least 25 years old

OR

 - is at least 15 years old and
 - is one of a limited number produced by the manufacturer for that model year, or
 - is one no longer manufactured because the manufacturer that owns the "trademark" or "make" of that vehicle has ceased manufacturing vehicles of any kind for at least the last 5 years.
- When licensed as a collector vehicle, (a) will be used solely for pleasure purposes and will not at any time be used for driving to or from or part way to or from work or school, (b) will not be used during the period from 1/2 hour after sunset to 1/2 hour before sunrise unless the described vehicle is equipped with lamps and reflectors that comply with Division 4 of the Motor Vehicle Act Regulations.

For Insurance purposes:

I/we solemnly declare that when the above described vehicle is licensed and insured as a collector vehicle at the reduced collector vehicle premiums;

- it will be used solely for pleasure purposes and not for driving to or from, or part way to or from, work or school, and,
- I/we own or lease another licensed non-collector motor vehicle or motorcycle, or have a licensed non-collector motor vehicle or motorcycle as a company assigned vehicle that is insured for general transportation purposes in one of the following rate classes 001, 002, 003, 004, 005, 007, 011, 012, 013, 014, 015, 017, 021, 022, 023, 024, 027, 310 to 314, or 320 to 324.

In signing this application, I/we declare that all the foregoing statements are true, and that I/we make these declarations with the intention that the Insurance Corporation of British Columbia will rely on the same.

 (C) Has had any aftermarket non-factory options installed other than those permitted on the MV1425A.

Licensing Requirements

Collector Licence Plate(s) may be issued in compliance with the following:

1. The collector vehicle must be at least:
 - 25 years old, or
 - 15 years old and:
 - (a) is a limited production vehicle¹ produced by the manufacturer for that model year, or
 - (b) where the manufacturer that owns the “trademark” of that vehicle has ceased making vehicles²
2. The vehicle must be maintained or restored to a condition which conforms with the vehicle manufacturer’s original specifications with the exception of upgrading of brakes, headlights, the installation of seatbelts, safety glass or other items satisfactory to ICBC and is in a condition that makes it of significant value to a collector or exhibitor of vehicles.
3. The vehicle must be fully assembled.
4. The model year of the vehicle must be the model year designated by the manufacturer of the vehicle, not the production year.
5. Must be a manufactured motor vehicle (not a replicar, replikit, modified cab/chassis, motorhome or kit car).
6. The vehicle must be in exceedingly good stock condition regardless of age.

Criteria for Collector Vehicles and Motorcycles 15 to 24 Years Old

1. BASIC VEHICLE/MOTORCYCLE LINE — Motorcycles must be identifiable by the manufacturers’ identification numbers, while vehicles must be identified by the manufacturer² as a unique model and/or special edition vehicle using the body/chassis VIN identifier, AND
2. LIMITED PRODUCTION VEHICLES/MOTORCYCLES — No more than 1,500 of that model vehicle/motorcycle line may have been produced by the manufacturer² **worldwide** for that model year (see note below), OR
3. DISCONTINUED PRODUCTION VEHICLES/MOTORCYCLES — Vehicle/motorcycle no longer manufactured because the manufacturer that owns the “trademark” or “make” of that vehicle has ceased manufacturing vehicles of any kind for at least the last 5 years. The applicant may be required to provide proof.

¹Where we cannot ascertain production figures, ICBC will accept a letter from the manufacturer, on its letterhead, attesting to the number produced. The letter should also indicate the physical description of the vehicle and quote the full vehicle identification number.

²A recognized manufacturer of vehicles is a corporation that is or has been engaged in the regular production of new vehicles (this does not include replicars).

Conditions of Use

The collector vehicle:

- will be used solely for pleasure purposes and will not at any time be used for driving to or from or part way to or from work or school.
- will not be used during the period from 1/2 hour after sunset to 1/2 hour before sunrise unless the described vehicle is equipped with lamps and reflectors that comply with Division 4 of the Motor Vehicle Act Regulations.

Appearance/Condition — Collector Cars and Trucks

(a) EXTERIOR:

- (i) Paint — Stock appearance. No primer, blemishes or missing trim. No visible body rust or bubbling. No dents or chips in bodywork or bumpers. No stickers, except Combat Auto Theft (C.A.T.) stickers, club emblems or badges.
- (ii) Wheels — Wheels and hubcaps appropriate to the era of manufacture. Documentation will be required for era correct aftermarket wheels.
- (iii) Tires — Stock appearance. Radials okay if kept in the spirit of original issue.
- (iv) Convertible top — Undamaged and in good working condition.

(b) INTERIOR:

- (i) Sound system — Era correct aftermarket sound systems including speaker grills, cassette decks or CD players. May upgrade equipment by replacing tubes with transistors, providing the appearance and function of the radio remains era correct.
- (ii) Upholstery — Restored or good original condition, including seats, door panels, headliners, dashboard, armrests. If the vehicle is primarily in original condition, minor neat repairs to the original upholstery are acceptable. Seat covers, except originals, must be removed to display original seats. Lack of maintenance (rips, grease stains, torn seams, etc.) may disqualify the vehicle.
- (iii) Flooring/carpeting — Original or reproductions in good condition.

(c) ENGINE COMPARTMENT:

- (i) Exceptionally clean. No rust, grime, dirt or chipped paint. Detailed if necessary.
- (ii) Era correct options only. Aftermarket dressup should be era correct.
- (iii) Engine should be stock engine for the year of manufacture. Era correct headers, intake manifolds and replacement carburetors.
- (iv) No propane or natural gas conversions acceptable unless OEM fitted.

(d) **BODY/CHASSIS:**

- (i) No alterations from stock, including chopping, channeling, lowering, aftermarket suspensions, blacked-out or darkened windows, chroming of stock parts, or camperized vehicles. Hot rods and modified vehicles are also not acceptable.
- (ii) Era specific non-factory options e.g., extra chrome, instrumentation (tachometers, etc.), custom steering wheels, CBs, canopies, campers, etc. may be permitted.

We will consider the following exceptions, providing they are in keeping with the era of manufacture of motor vehicle; exterior sun visors, fog lamps, rear bumpers on trucks, mud flaps, temperature, ammeter and oil gauges, air-conditioning, continental kits, trailer hitches on vehicles equipped with towing packages sufficient for towing a trailer.

Factory Options: Due to the large number of factory stock options available at the time of manufacture, you may be required to produce factory literature to authenticate that your vehicle conforms with the manufacturer's original specifications, and that any options on the vehicle are approved factory stock options.

Appearance/Condition – Collector Motorcycles

Include the model number, serial number, and frame number if possible, otherwise your application may be returned.

- (a) Paint – Presentable stock appearance including decals and trim. No primer, paint blemishes, visible sheet metal or frame rust (except originals).
- (b) Wheels – Era correct.
- (c) Tires – Kept in the spirit of the original issue.
- (d) Sheet Metal, Frame and Motor Components – era specific is acceptable. No inappropriate chrome. Aftermarket headers/exhaust/aircleaners, handlebars must be era specific.
- (e) Accessories – Must be era specific.

Applying for Collector Vehicle Status

If your vehicle meets the requirements outlined above, complete an *Application for Authorization for Collector Vehicle Status* (MV1425). These application forms are available at any Autoplan Agent or on www.icbc.com.

Attach colour **photographs** of the vehicle and, where required, a valid passed AirCare Test certificate as detailed on the application form (MV1425). Send the application to:

Initial Application for Licensing and Insurance

When the authorized application has been returned to you, present it to your Autoplan Agent who will order your collector plate.

Please allow one week for delivery of the Collector Plates to the agent's office.

Qualifying for Collector Rate Class and Insurance

Collector vehicle status does not automatically entitle a person to reduced-premium insurance. To qualify for a collector rate class and reduced premiums, the applicant must own or lease a non-collector motor vehicle for general transportation purposes THAT IS:

- registered and licensed in B.C., **AND**
- insured in rate class 001, 002, 003, 004, 005, 007, 011, 012, 013, 014, 015, 017, 021, 022, 023, 024, 027, 310, 311, 312, 313, 314, 320, 321, 322, 323 or 324.

Company-owned vehicles may qualify as general transportation vehicles, provided they meet the criteria above and so long as the applicant is the assigned operator for the company vehicle.

If You Have No General Transportation Vehicle

If you do not own/lease a qualifying general transportation vehicle you may display collector plates on your vehicle, but the collector vehicle must:

- be rated in rate class 001, 005, 021 or one of the 300-series motorcycle rate classes, **AND**
- (as with all collector vehicles) cannot be used for driving to or from, or part way to or from, work or school.
