**EXTERIOR.** 1 full front view; 1 full rear view; 1 each of right and left sides; 1 of trunk with lid open (or tailgate down); 1 engine compartment; and 1 with convertible top up if convertible model.  
**INTERIOR.** 1 full dashboard; 1 driver's seat (seat covers removed except originals); 1 driver's side floor (loose floor mats removed).  
 Please **DO NOT** submit Polaroid photographs or photocopies. Digital images must be printed on glossy paper, be of high resolution and unaltered from the original image.
- A copy of the *Application to Register a Modified Motor Vehicle (MV1437)*.

**STATEMENT OF APPLICANT**

**For LICENCING purposes:**

I hereby solemnly declare that I am a resident of the Province of British Columbia and that the motor vehicle described above:

- Is in, and will remain in a condition that makes it of significant value to a collector or exhibitor of motor vehicles.
- Is registered in British Columbia as a modified 1958 or earlier model and complies with the conditions contained in the *Application to Register a Modified Motor Vehicle (MV1437)*, which is incorporated into this declaration.
- When licensed as a collector motor vehicle, a) will be used solely for pleasure purposes and will not at any time be used for driving to or from or part way to or from work or school, b) will not be used during the period from 1/2 hour after sunset to 1/2 hour before sunrise or when, because of insufficient light or unfavourable conditions, persons or vehicles are not clearly discernable at a distance of 150 metres, unless the described vehicle is equipped with lamps and reflectors that comply with Division 4 of the Motor Vehicle Act Regulations.

**For INSURANCE purposes:**

I solemnly declare that when the above described motor vehicle is licensed and insured as a collector vehicle at the reduced collector motor vehicle premiums;

- it will be used solely for pleasure purposes and not for driving to or from, or part way to or from, work or school, and,
- I own or lease another licensed non-collector motor vehicle or motorcycle, or have a licensed non-collector motor vehicle or motorcycle as a company assigned vehicle that is insured for general transportation purposes in one of the following rate classes 001, 002, 003, 004, 005, 007, 011, 012, 013, 014, 015, 017, 021, 022, 023, 024, 027, 310 to 314, or 320 to 324.

In signing this application, I declare that all the foregoing statements are true, and that I make these declarations with the intention that the Insurance Corporation of British Columbia will rely on the same.

**WARNING**

Where the owner in this application or the MV1437 gives false particulars to the prejudice of the corporation or knowingly misrepresents or fails to disclose in this application any fact required to be stated herein, or uses the motor vehicle contrary to the statement made above, insurance coverage may be forfeited.

## BRITISH COLUMBIA REQUIREMENTS FOR AUTHORIZATION, LICENSING AND INSURING MODIFIED COLLECTOR MOTOR VEHICLES (CARS AND TRUCKS)

**IMPORTANT:** Before applying to license and insure your modified collector motor vehicle you must first register the vehicle, using the *Application to Register a Modified Motor Vehicle (MV1437)*.

### LICENSING REQUIREMENTS

To qualify for Collector licence plate(s) the motor vehicle must:

- a) be registered in British Columbia as a modified 1958 or earlier model and comply with the statements in the *Application to Register a Modified Motor Vehicle (MV1437)*,
- b) have a valid passed AirCare Test Certificate, where required,
- c) be fully assembled,
- d) not be a replicar, modified commercial vehicle (formerly cab/chassis), motor home or replikit (kit car),
- e) be in a condition that makes it of significant value to a collector or exhibitor of vehicles. Please see "Vehicle Condition" below.

### CONDITIONS OF USE

1. The motor vehicle can only be used for pleasure purposes. It cannot be used at any time for driving to and from, or part way to and from, work or school.
2. The motor vehicle cannot be used from 1/2 hour after sunset to 1/2 hour before sunrise or when, because of insufficient light or unfavourable conditions, persons or vehicles are not clearly discernable at a distance of 150 metres, unless it is equipped with lamps and reflectors that comply with Division 4 of the Motor Vehicle Act Regulations.

### INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

The motor vehicle may only be insured at reduced modified collector motor vehicle premiums if:

- a) the motor vehicle is used solely for pleasure purposes and not for driving to or from, or part way to or from, work or school, **and**,
- b) the owner of the modified collector motor vehicle owns or leases another licensed non-collector motor vehicle or motorcycle, or has a licensed non-collector motor vehicle or motorcycle as a company assigned vehicle that is insured for general transportation purposes in rate classes 001, 002, 003, 004, 005, 007, 011, 012, 013, 014, 015, 017, 021, 022, 023, 024, 027, 310 to 314, or 320 to 324.

### VEHICLE CONDITION

To qualify for Collector licence plates, ICBC must be satisfied that the motor vehicle is in exceptional condition, regardless of age. The following factors, among others, will be considered.

#### BODY/CHASSIS:

- i. Body/chassis in exceptional condition. No dents/chips in bodywork or bumpers. No missing trim.
- ii. Paint in good condition. No visible body rust or bubbling. No primer, paint chips or blemishes.
- iii. Any convertible top must be undamaged and in good working condition.

#### INTERIOR:

- i. Flooring, carpeting and upholstery must be in exceptional condition, including seats, door panels, headliners, dashboard and armrests. Rips, grease stains, torn seams, etc. will disqualify the vehicle.

#### ENGINE COMPARTMENT:

- i. No rust, grime, dirt or chipped paint. Must be exceptionally clean. (Detailed if necessary.)

### AUTHORIZATION FOR MODIFIED COLLECTOR MOTOR VEHICLE STATUS

1. Apply for authorization to license and insure your motor vehicle using the *Application for Authorization for Modified Collector Motor Vehicle Status (MV1426)* form, which is available at any Autoplan Agent or at [www.icbc.com](http://www.icbc.com).

Once the application is approved by ICBC and returned to you, take it to your Autoplan Agent who will order your collector plate.
